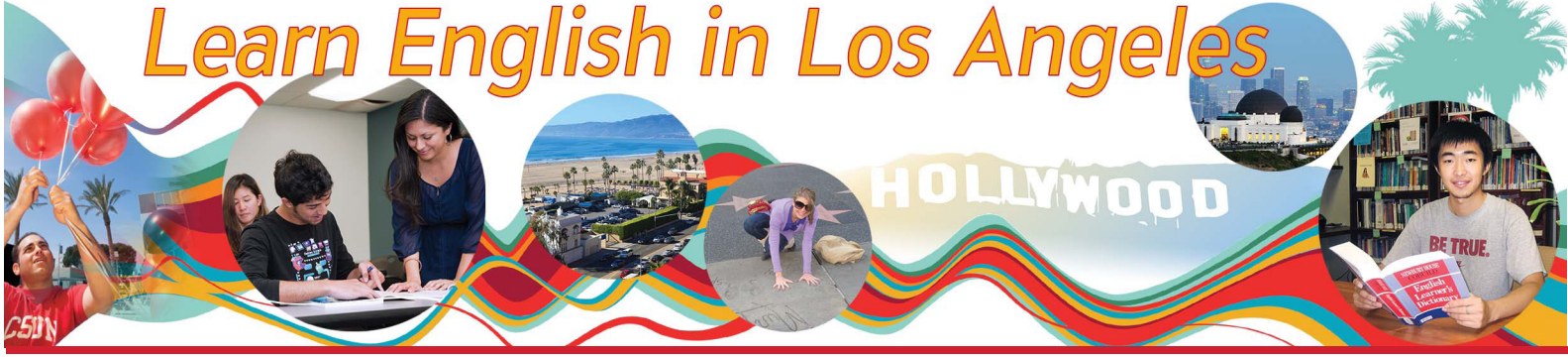

The IEP Program gives you:

- Three categories of learning: Foundation, Academic Skills (1-5) and University Bridge
• Foundation: supporting and mentoring beginning-level students
• English for Academic Skills: reading, writing, listening, speaking, and TOEFL/IELTS preparation
• University Bridge for a smooth academic transition and preparation for the undergraduate and graduate TOEFL waiver option
• Conditional admission to CSUN and selected colleges/universities on degree and credit programs
• Over 20 hours of instruction plus supplemental classes and one-on-one tutoring
• Highly-qualified faculty with graduate degrees
• Option to Take University Classes (TUC) for credit at Academic Skills level 3 and above
• Academic advisement and counseling including Student Life matters
• Official ETS TOEFL on-site testing

How to Apply

Intensive English Program* (IEP):

2. IEP application fee (\$150)
3. First term tuition fee
4. Evidence of financial support
5. Copy of passport

Conditional Admission* (In addition to 1-5):

- 6. CSUN application (www.csun.edu/go/applyIEPCA)
7. CSUN application fee (\$55)
8. Conditional Admission fee (\$100)
9. Official transcript from high school or college/university.
10. Proof of graduation from high school or college/university.

Graduate Applicants: three (3) recommendation letters; a statement of purpose; resume/cv; and visit www.csun.edu/graduatestudies for additional requirements.

*PLEASE NOTE: Applicants must be at least 18 years old. All supporting documents are DUE two (2) weeks after the application deadline. All official documents must be submitted in their original language, together with an English translation.

English Language and Cultural Experience (ELCE)

Improve your English-language proficiency and knowledge of American culture in three weeks. This program combines classroom learning with recreational activities on and around campus, such as pool parties, shopping, dining at local restaurants and visits to museums and exhibitions.

ELCE is open to groups and individual students. On-campus housing and facilities are available. And students will receive a certificate of participation at the end of the program.
