- Minimum of GPA 2.0 for undergraduate level students, and a minimum GPA or 2.5 for graduate level students, based on 4.0 grading system from an accredited institution
- Meet one or more of the accepted CSUN English-language proficiency minimum scores
- Submit the following:

2. Application Fee (\$300)
3. Program Fee (\$500)
4. First term tuition fee
5. Evidence of financial support
6. Copy of passport
7. Copy of acceptable English proficiency exam score
8. Copy of official transcript from high school or college/university*
9. Preferred course schedule
