## Note: It is much easier to use your I-20 in your home country to apply for an F-1 visa, but if you decide to apply for a Change of Status while staying in the US, be aware that

- $\rightarrow$  Your passport must be valid and you must be admitted to a program in this college.
- $\rightarrow$  You CANNOT attend school while waiting for your change of status to go through.
- $\rightarrow$  You CANNOT work while waiting for your change of status to go through.
- $\rightarrow$  If you leave the US while your COS is pending, your application becomes invalid.
